WORLD PEACE

Nowhere can the significance of peace be more illustrated than in the fact that the Charter of the United Nations clearly gives it the primary priority. It could not be claimed that this by itself must insure international peace. The genuine commitment of all nations to cooperate within the United Nations framework towards this end is definitely indispensable. Since the dawn of history peace has always been an ultimate objective the dire need for which is accentuated by the dismal effects of conflicts that continue to plague humanity and dampen the prospects of progress for the underdeveloped segments of it.

The conflict control that international peace entails is a basic element of the primary responsibility of all United Nations Member States, especially the five permanent ones at the Security Council. And it is on the recognition of such a crucial element that we pin our hopes for the survival of mankind.

The fulfillment of these hopes shall not materialize unless all nations cooperate at the well-defined stages towards negotiated solutions for the high-stakes problems such as those

of the Palestinian people, the native nations of Southern

Africa, the Iran-Iraq war, Afghanistan, Central America,

Kampuchea, Third World debt and others. Against the backdrop

of such barriers to peace we are more than ever in need of a

fresh collective look at the major problems and at the best

approaches to arrest and reverse the erosion of multilateralism

which is another grave menace to international peace.
