On behalf of all Canadians, I am delighted to be able to welcome the Sri Chinmoy Oneness-Home Peace Run to our Nation's Capital.

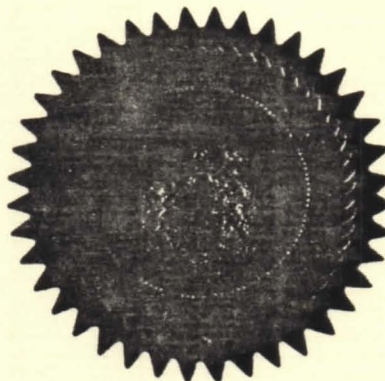
