Today Mr. Kirdar spoke to the Meditation Group. I am so deeply moved by him. His mind is illumined and his heart is full of receptivity A man like him is very, very rare. Look at his soul's maturity! His soul's divine maturity has entered into his entire being. From the soul it has entered into his heart, and from his heart it has entered into his mind and his outer expression. Because of his inner wisdom, how smilingly he can disarm everybody! His inner wisdom—light has entered into his mind, and this mental illumination is very rare. Usually the heart has its own aspiration and the mind has its own illumination, if it at all has illumination. In his case, mental illumination and psychic aspiration go together. We can say that his soul's delight has entered into his heart's aspiration, and his heart's aspiration has entered into his mind. Like him there are very, very few people.

When he smiles, we can see all at once the pure ancient world of wisdom and the modern world—not the sophisticated world, but the new world of simplicity and innocence. When the new age dawns, it will be an age of utmost simplicity and innocence, which we see in Mr. Kirdar's smile. In him is the combination of the future and the past. His life unites the ancient wisdom of the past and the dynamic simplicity, sincerity and humility of the future.

The world needs understanding, not only on the mental plane, but on all planes. Mr. Kirdar's understanding is all-embracing. The fate of the United Nations and the fate of the world will change when people can see the reality on all the various planes of consciousness.
