"Spirit of the UN " Award Recipients 2014



H.E. Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Flores Flake, appointed Ambassador to the United Nations after being a leading political figure in Honduras, particularly as the Vice-President of the National Congress. Known as a reformer, working for human rights, education, and justice, she represents the Honduras Government of Unity and Reconciliation, and is a member of the Executive Board of the International Association of Permanent Representatives. She served as Vice-President of the 67th Session of the UN General Assembly.



Ms. Gay Rosemblum-Kumar has worked with the United Nations for the past 25 years, most recently leading the Secretariat of the UN Interagency Framework Team for Preventive Action (FT), an informal mechanism supporting conflict prevention and transformation. She played a major role in developing new conceptual and operational approaches to early conflict prevention and policy and practice in the UN System. Presently, she continues peacebuilding initiatives concerning conflict and violence prevention .



Mr. Tairiku Okada is Spiritual Leader of Sukyo Mahikari 2002, and serves as the President of Forum 21 Institute. Mr. Okada is Chairman of the Board of Hkaru Museum which studies the underlying unity of the earth's civilizations. He promotes key community service projects for youth. He worked to co-sponsored the UN Millennium World Peace Summit of Religious and Spiritual Leaders in 2000, and in 2006 addressed the UN on transcending barriers of race, religion, nationality and ideology.



Ms. Mirian Vilela is Executive Director of the Earth Charter International Secretariat and the Center for Education for Sustainable Development at UPEACE. She is coordinating the newly established UNESCO Chair on Education for Sustainable Development with the Earth Charter. She has extensive experience working with the UN Earth Summit, UNCTAD, World Summit on Sustainable Development and Rio+20. She facilitated numerous international seminars on the values and principles of sustainability.



Mrs. Sharon Hamilton-Getz is President and founder of World Harmony Council and Forum. She is a public speaker to international audiences, and as an interfaith minister, she travelled globally as an ambassador of good will and led conferences on cross-cultural understanding and the emempowerment of women. She is Chair-Emerita and Co-Founder of the NGO Committee on Spirituality, Values and Global Concerns-NY at the United Nations.
